Rules and Regulations

1. Any entries incurring bank fees will be charged \$50.00 plus cost of the bank fee and the original bill.
2. **Refunds** will be made upon receipt of a vet (or Dr.) certificate & must be received by show manager before end of show for consideration.
3. Every Class recognized by MHA will be conducted & judged under the current rules of the MHA. MHA rated class specifications can be read in the current MHA Rule Book on line: www.mainehorseassoc.com
4. Every Class recognized by 4-H will be conducted & judged under the current Maine 4-H rules. Maine State 4-H mandates that 4-H events must be free to 4-Hers; thus no charge for the 4-H classes.
5. Please note: 4-H ages are 18 and under as of October 1, 2017. Horse Show ages for all other classes are as of the previous December 1 (12/1/17) Horse show 'junior exhibitors' are 17 and under.
6. MHA membership applications will be available at the Show Office. You may join the day of the show & receive points.
7. Six (6) ribbons awarded per class.
8. Water and coffee available at the Secretary's Booth. Food available on the fairgrounds.
9. The Ossipee Valley Fair Association, the Ossipee Valley Agricultural Society, the Show Committee, MHA or their agents or employees, and/or 4-H will not be responsible for any accident which may occur to rider, groom, attendant, spectator, animal, or equipment at the show. Nor will any of the aforementioned be held responsible for loss or destruction of any property or equipment or damage to or by animals at the Show or on the grounds.
10. Entry into additional classes must be made a minimum of 3 classes prior to the entered class.
11. No dogs on the show grounds per Ossipee Fair rules.
12. No alcoholic beverages will be permitted on the show grounds during the show.

13. PROOF of current rabies and negative Coggins will be required to show. Please also include vaccination records (Rhino, influenza, EEE, WEE, etc) and registraton papers (for minis).
14. To be eligible for its respective Championship class, the entry must have been entered, shown and judged in the class in parentheses ()

Directions to Ossipee Valley Fair Grounds:

From the Portland area, take Route 25 west to Cornish. Bear right on the South Hiram Road at Moulton Lumber Company. The fairgrounds are 2 miles from Route 25 on the South Hiram Road.

From New Hampshire, take Route 25 east to the village of Kezar Falls. Just before the bridge, turn lef on Bridge Street
- then right on Main Street (which becomes South Hiram Road at the town line).

The fairgrounds are just 2 miles from Route 25 from either direction. See you there!

5. Western Horse in Hand
6. Halter Horse/Pony, Junior Handler (17 & Under)
7. Halter Horse/Pony, Open
8. English Horse in Hand
9. Miniature Horse in Hand
10. Halter Horse/Pony Championship (5, 6, 7, 8, 9) MHA points only if entered, shown & judged in Class 6)
11. Miniature Horse Obstacles
12. Lead Line Pleasure Horse/Pony, Riders 7 Yrs. & Under
13. Lead Line Equitation, Open, Riders 7 Yrs. & Under
14. Walk-Trot Pleasure Horse/Pony, 11 & Over (including adults)
15. 4-H Walk-Trot Pleasure (18 & under) – riders not eligible for classes requiring a canter/lope at this show
16. Walk-Trot Pleasure Horse/Pony, 10 yrs & Under
17. 4-H English Equitation

18. Hunter Pleasure Equitation (Jr Exhibitors & Amateur Adults)
19. 4-H English Pleasure
20. MHA English Pleasure Horse - Open to members & non-members with no residency restrictions
21. Adult Equitation, Open (18 & Over)
22. 4-H Western Equitation
23. Western Seat Equitation, 17 & under
24. 4-H Western Pleasure
25. MHA Western Pleasure
25. Youth Activity Pleasure Horse, Open (17 & under)
27. MHA Medallion Pleasure Horse/Pony - Open to members & non-members with no residency restrictions
28. Costume Class, Open (shown at a walk only; lead line and walk-trotters are eligible)

29. 4-H Trail Class (not MHA pointed)
30. Trail Horse. Open
31. Family Pleasure Class – Open to two family members OR two “barn family” members. One exhibitor to ride one way of the ring and the second exhibitor to show the second way of the ring. Entries must be ridden. Exchange of riders to be done in the ring. To be shown at a walk, trot or jog. Excessive speed will be penalized. To be judged on manners, performance and quality. Full show clothes are not required. Shirt, pants and heeled boots are required.
- 32 Egg and Spoon, Open
33. Water Glass Class, Open - Rider to hold cup filled with water and ride as instructed. Entry with most water in cup at end of the class wins. (not MHA pointed)
